

Dr. Noel Hynes Memorial Scholarship



Dr. H.B. Noel Hynes was the world's most renowned freshwater biologist and a Distinguished Emeritus Professor at the University of Waterloo. Referred to as "the father of running-water ecology", he has published extensively, including his definitive textbook on river ecology, *The Ecology of Running Waters*. Dr. Hynes has conducted research around the world while holding six visiting professor appointments on three continents. He was awarded the Naumann-Thienemann Medal in 1998, the highest award available to an aquatic biologist by the Societas Internationalis Limnologiae. Dr. Hynes is a Fellow of the Royal Society of Canada, and holds honorary degrees from his alma mater, the University of London, and the University of Waterloo. The Dr. Noel Hynes Memorial Graduate Scholarship in Biology has been created to honour his memory.
